



## ARTICLES OF THE FAITH

- I. We believe in YAHUWAH - The God of Avraham, Yitzhaq and Ya'aqob, Our Heavenly Father: The Self-Existent Creator and Sustainer of All Things; The Almighty; And Beside Him There Is No Other.
- II. We Believe in Ha Mashiach/Christ - Yahushua; The Only Begotten Son of YAH: The King of Kings and Lord of Lords; The Messiah of The Commonwealth of Yisrael, and the Savior of Just Men Everywhere.
- III. We Believe in Ruach Ha Qodesh - The Holy Spirit; Sent to Fill Each Believer; To Guide the Holy Nation into All Truth; To Empower the Faithful to Live an Overcoming Life; And to Reprove the World of Sin, of Righteousness and of Judgment.
- IV. We Believe in the 'Tanakh' And B'rit Ha Chadashah - The Holy Bible; The Inerrant, 'Yah-Breathed' Revelation unto The Holy Kings, Priests and Prophets of Yisrael.
- V. We Believe in The Laws, Statutes and Commandments Of YAH - As It Is Written, "Here Is the Patience of The Saints: Here Are They That Keep the Commandments of YAHUWAH *and* The Faith of Yahushua" (Rev. 14:12).
- VI. We Believe in The Blood Atonement - The Sacred Blood of Mashiach; Untouched by The Taint of Fallen Mankind; Shed to Redeem the Souls and Remit the Sins of The Just; Once and For All Time, Unto Eternal Life.
- VII. We Believe in The Doctrine of Mashiach - The Three-Fold Foundational Principles Upon Which the Renewed Covenant Is Established.
- VIII. We Believe in The High Priestly Prayer of Mashiach - The Call to Oneness Through A Common Partaking of The Bread, Which Is His Body; The Word of YAH.
- IX. We Believe in The Legacy of Hebrew Yisraelites - The Physical Descendants of The Ancient Kingdom of Yisrael, The So-Called African American In Mashiach; Together with The Natural House of Yisrael In Mashiach, As the Rightful and Legal Executors of The Divine Covenants, And the Primary Heirs of The Promises Therein.
